





Classic Rovos Rail & Cape Town







Namibia & South Africa Explorer

Set off early to Spitzkoppe - home of the 'Matterhorn of Namibia', where endless dry plains give rise to a vast island of granite peaks. Explore the rock formations and visit a local Damara school. (B,D)

Day 7 Walvis Bay - Namib Desert

Drive along the ocean road to reach Walvis Bay, a wide open lagoon home to flamingo and pelican populations, before spending a night in a lodge in Naukluft National Park, (B.D.)

Days 8 & 9 Namib Desert

Summit Dune 45 for sweeping panoramas of the red sand dunes at first light and travel through the desert. (B,D)

Day 10 Auz

Discover abandoned diamond mining town, Kolmanskop, and historic coastal

Day 11 Fish River Canyon

Take in astounding views at the edge of the world's second largest canyon. (B,D)

Days 12-14 South Africa

Sample local wines in the Stellenbosch region before discovering stylish Cape Town and Table Mountain. (B,D)
