

# Costa Rica Highlights

Spend 12-days hopping between some of Costa Rica's best-loved natural wonders and varied ecosystems to discover why this country is a nature lover's paradise. From San José head into the Central Valley to find La Paz Waterfall hidden in the lush tropical forest. Continue to the Caribbean Coast to spend two nights in Tortuguero National Park and watch (season depending) turtles lay their eggs or hatch.





After exploring the jungle-fringed waterways – home to over half the bird species found in Costa Rica - relocate to the comfortable Arenal Kioro Suites & Spa at the base of the magnificent volcano. Here, opt to spend time walking, river rafting, visiting wildlife refuges or sightseeing from hanging bridges. Arrive at Monteverde Cloud Forest to spot Resplendent guetzal, horse ride or even try a night-safari to meet the nocturnal fauna. Finally, trade the mist-shrouded jungle for Manuel Antonio National Park's protected Pacific beaches, mangrove swamp and biodiverse forest.

## NICARAGUA Monteverde Cloud Forest This mountainous region of emerald cloud forest boasts an astounding level of biodiversity. 0000 Resplendent quetzal can be spotted and monkeys

## Arenal Volcano National Park

Arenal Volcano is one of Costa Rica's most-snapped sights. The fertile lowlands surrounding this dormant stratovolcano are home to natural waterfalls, mountains for hiking and rivers ready to be rafted.

## Tortuguero National Park

Each year between July and October, this park is one of the most important nesting sites in the world for Green sea turtles. It also protects the surrounding forests, canals and lagoons that are home to alligators and iguanas.



## Tamarindo

Tamarindo is the most developed beach resort on the Guanacaste Coast. Between October and March, visit the beaches of nearby Las Baulas National Marine Park to watch endangered Leatherback turtles nesting after the sun sets.


